

Applicants for
Value Adjustment Board Attorney

Opportunities now exist for attorneys who are licensed in the State of Florida and meet the following criteria to serve as the legal counsel for the 2012 tax cycle for the Value Adjustment Board of Wakulla County.

- 1) Applicant must be an attorney in private practice and may not be an elected or appointed official or an employee of Wakulla County, a taxing jurisdiction, or the State.
- 2) Applicant must have practiced law for over five years and meet the requirements of Section 194.015, Florida Statutes and fill the role prescribed by F.A.C. 12D-9.009. An attorney may represent more than one Value Adjustment Board.
- 3) The primary role of the board legal counsel shall be to advise the board on all aspects of the Value Adjustment Board review process to ensure that all actions taken by the board and its appointees meets the requirements of law.
- 4) The board attorney is expected to attend all Value Adjustment Meetings and hearings and to provide assistance to the Value Adjustment Board as needed. This is an independent-contractor position and a rate will be negotiated.
- 5) Applicant need not be a resident of Wakulla County.
- 6) Applicant must complete Department of Revenue training for Value Adjustment Boards and provide a statement acknowledging receipt of the training to the Board Clerk.
